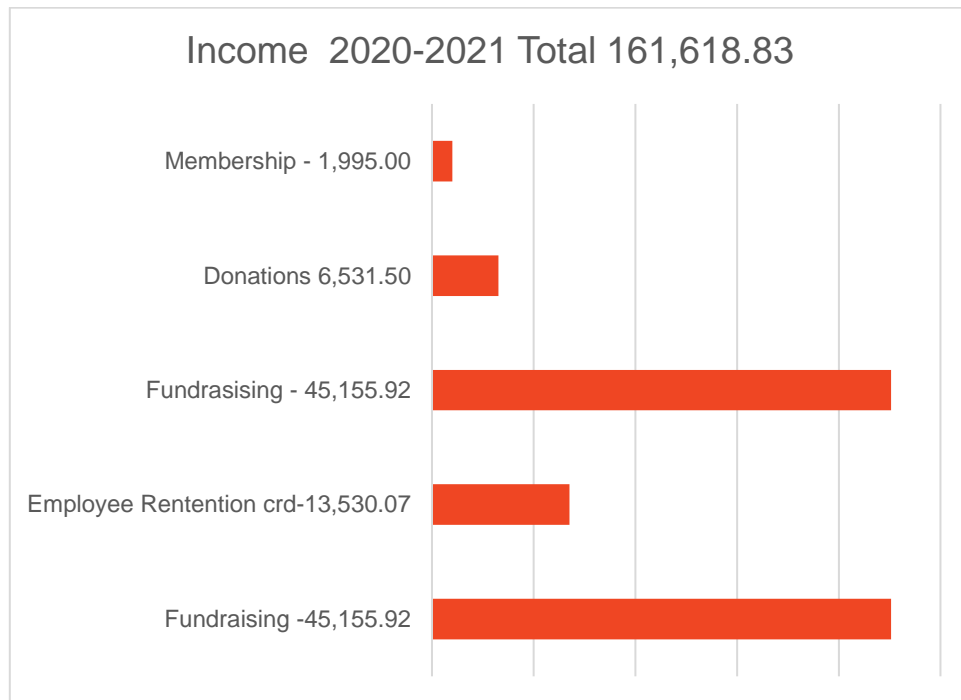
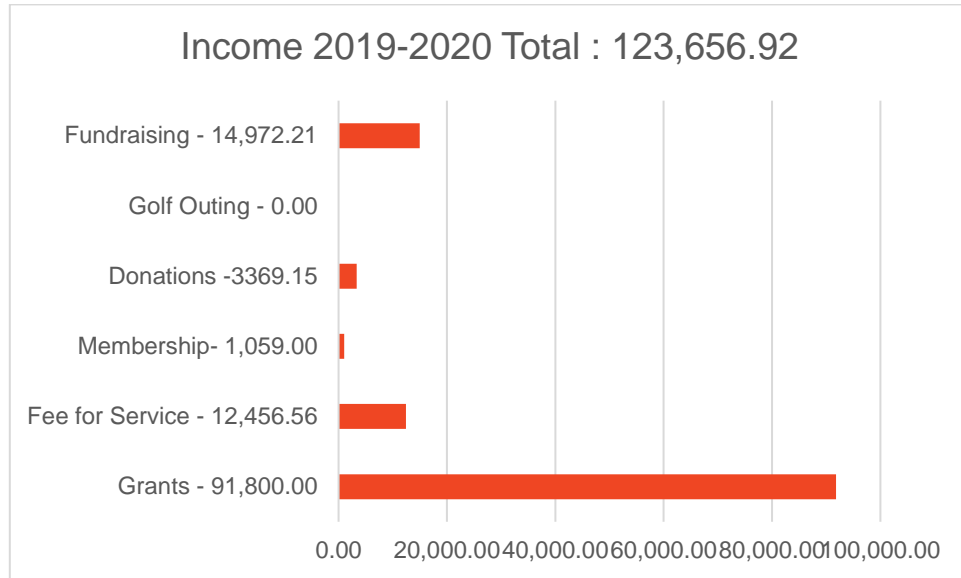

Looking Ahead

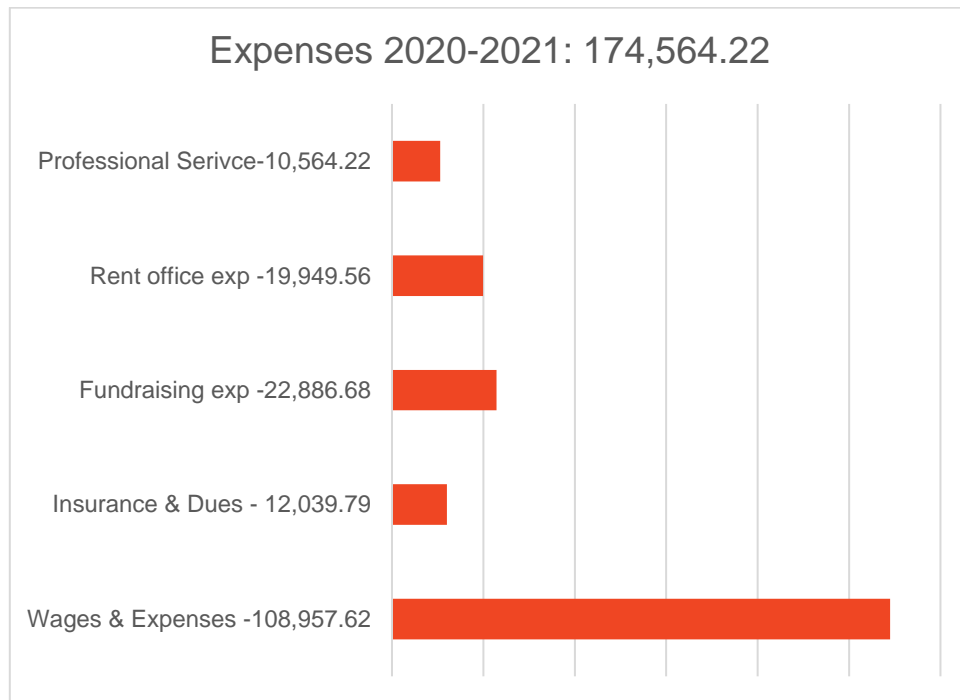
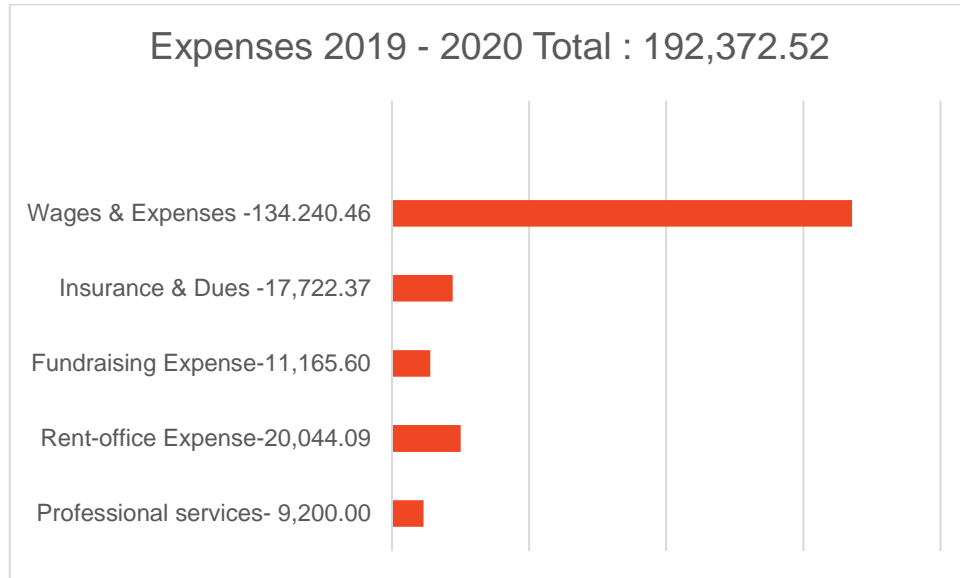
